The next thing I see is the Bride of Europe slowly raising up from the Land of Europe. She stands confident and is carrying a staff like Moses.



“Awake, O north wind, And come,

She starts blowing a wind over the countries in the North of Europe (Norway, Denmark, Germany, Netherlands, the UK and Sweden).

I get the feeling that the wind represents the power of the Holy Spirit that is released in a greater measure over these countries. Together with this wind I get the impression that the North-wind is blowing, which in Song of Songs 4:16 represent the test of obedience and humility in the midst of trials.



The next thing I see is the bride swinging her staff and a round rainbow appears in the sky.

I see rats appear in the homes of the people, eating the crumbs of all that is left. My impression is that this represents a famine or lack of food in general throughout the lands.

The next thing I see is that out of the round rainbow comes streams of water falling down. I also see trumpets blowing in the sky, and my feeling is that it represent two things:

1. Out of God's promise and tender mercy He will pour out waters and give provision supernaturally in times of need. I saw fresh green grass coming up from the ground. It might also be spiritual refreshment to God's people in the form of Living Waters.
2. The Church in Europe is rising up to release God's judgements on the earth and this will take form in many ways.

The last thing I heard was the Lord saying: "**Sing, sing, sing**". I felt it was an invitation for the Church to take her stand as a worshipping bride filling up the bowls in heaven.

(Rev 8:4-6). I also had the impression that it was connected to Isaiah Chapter 42, where as worship and prayer increases all over the different places of the Earth, the Lord Himself goes out like a mighty man of war.
